To do a paper in the Graduate Diploma of Theology or the Bachelor of Divinity at the Catholic Theological College in Auckland you need to be enrolled as an international student of the University of Notre Dame, Australia.

(We are the off-shore campus of the Catholic Institute of Sydney (CIS) which is partnered with the University of Notre Dame (UNDA) to deliver those papers).

There is no additional cost to this, (don't send any money to Australia!) but there is some work involved in following their several step online enrolment. It is a good idea to get started on this early.

It is a four step process.

- 1. Apply
- 2. Receive your offer
- 3. Accept
- 4. Enrol

New students can begin the application process. Their first move would be to submit an online application <a href="here">here</a> and to make known their intention to enrol as a student of CIS (when asked 'Why did you choose Notre Dame / this program?').



As regards programs

- Both domestic and international applicants must select Undergraduate (next to Applicant Type) in order to select B.Divinity as their program;
- International applicants seeking to undertake non-award study (i.e. the Graduate Diploma in Theology) must select Academic Pathway Program (next to Applicant Type) in order to select the appropriate 'not-for-degree' program (being NFD (UG) – Phil and Theology);
- <u>All</u> applicants should select **On Campus** as their Study Location.
